1. Lack of adequate funds for the tuition and up-keep costs

3. Lack of School Infirmary with apparatus/equipment
4. Lack of adequate funds for the maintenance of school buildings and deteriorating structures
5. Lack of financial resources for the establishment of income generation projects that would help sustain the activities of the centre
6. Shortage of essential buildings including :
 - Two laboratories, one for Chemistry and another for Biology
 - 4 classrooms and 3 dormitories for Advanced Level wing to be added to the school
 - Administration offices for non-teaching staff
 - A Computer room
 - A Geography room
 - A Multi purpose hall
 - A Domestic Science Laboratory
 - 8 teachers' houses

WHAT IS BETHSAIDA?

- A boarding secondary school for orphan girls only
- Established in 2006 with Registration No. S.2354
- Pupils do not pay for their tuition and upkeep at school
- The school relies on donations from individuals, groups and institutions with a heart for the orphaned girls
- Teaching is in accordance to the national curriculum for Form 1- 4 in Tanzania
- Computer and tailoring classes are held
- Teaching and non-teaching staff are all on volunteer service with stipends



WHO ARE BETHSAIDA STUDENTS?

- Girls who have lost both parents or have only one parent, who is severely sick or has a disability
- Orphans girls lacking appropriate care and support and who cannot access secondary education
- Orphans girls living in hazardous conditions
- Students are recruited from all over Tanzania and from all religions



WHAT DO WE TEACH AT BETHSAIDA?

For the national Form 4 examination we teach Civics Kiswahili, English, History Geography, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics.

Girls are also given training in Computer application skills, such as MS Word, MS Excel, MS PowerPoint, and in tailoring, arts and crafts, cookery and gardening



WHAT ARE OUR ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS?

Our students began doing Form IV national examinations in 2009. In spite of our challenges, the school has consistently held high regional and national rankings in the Form IV national examination result as shown below:

HIGH SCHOOL PLACEMENTS OVER PAST 3 YEARS

2013 batch: 8 out of the 27 students who sat for the national examination joined high schools in July 2014

2014 batch: 15 out of the 30 students who sat for the national examination joined high schools in July 2015

From the first batch of students in 2009 to date our graduates have gone on to join accredited higher education institutions in Tanzania, such as University of Dar Es Salaam, University of Dodoma, Ardhi University, National Institute of Transport, Muhimbili University of Health and Allied Sciences, Mzumbe University, Sokoine University of Agriculture, Tanzania Institute of Accountancy, and Institute of Finance Management, as well as colleges for teaching, nursing, business and tourism. Some of the students who were not selected to join either high school or university/college have attended short courses in entrepreneurship, such as fabrication of batik, production of soap, poultry farming, tailoring, cookery and arts and crafts for self employment.
