EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Bethsaida Secondary School, established in 2006, is a non-profit institution dedicated to providing quality education to underprivileged students, often referred to as an "orphanage school." Our mission is centered on delivering essential educational services without generating profit, focusing on the holistic development and well-being of our students. Over the years, we have proudly graduated over 400 students and earned recognition for our academic performance, which is a testament to our effective management and the support from our community, private sector, public institutions, and international donors.

However, we are currently facing several significant challenges. We have a monthly salary deficit of TZS 10,425,000 for our teachers and staff, which impacts our ability to retain and support our dedicated team. Additionally, more than 76 students are in need of donor support. To enhance the learning environment, we require 10 laptops for teachers and 20 students desktop computers. Our facilities are also in need of major rehabilitation, with an estimated cost of TZS 28,450,000 for repairs and upgrades to the kitchen, water systems, classrooms, and guest house. Furthermore, the monthly cost for student food and other operational expenses ranges between TZS 5,000,000 and TZS 7,000,000.

While this summary outlines our key needs, we also recognize that there are specific requirements related to our female students that are not detailed here. We invite and welcome any support or contributions aimed at addressing these needs. Your assistance is crucial in helping us overcome these challenges and continue providing quality education. We look forward to the possibility of partnering with you to make a meaningful difference in the lives of our students.

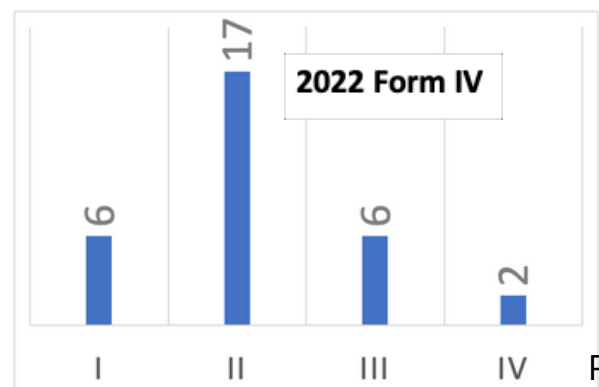
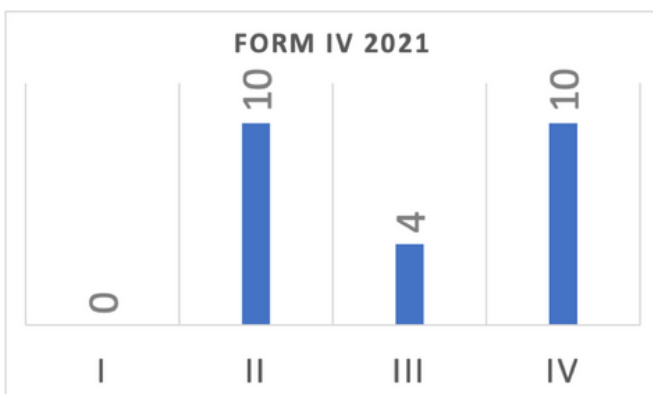


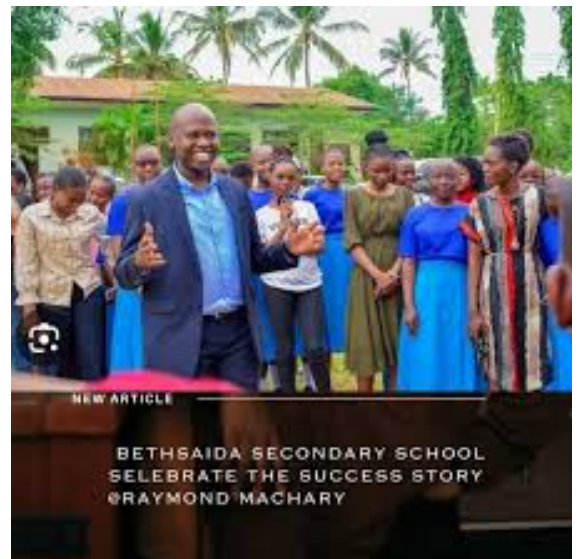
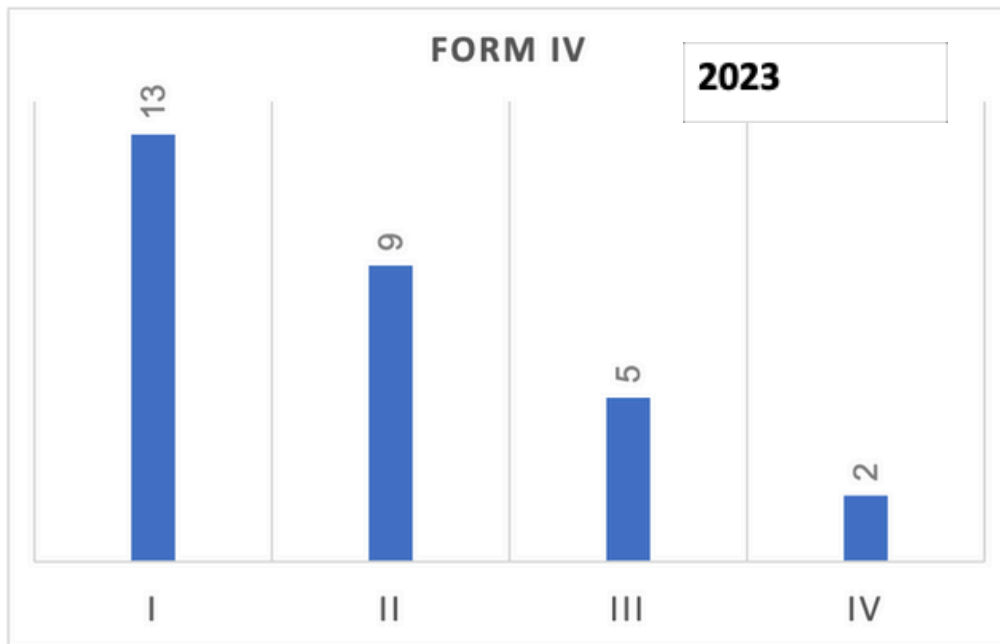
ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE

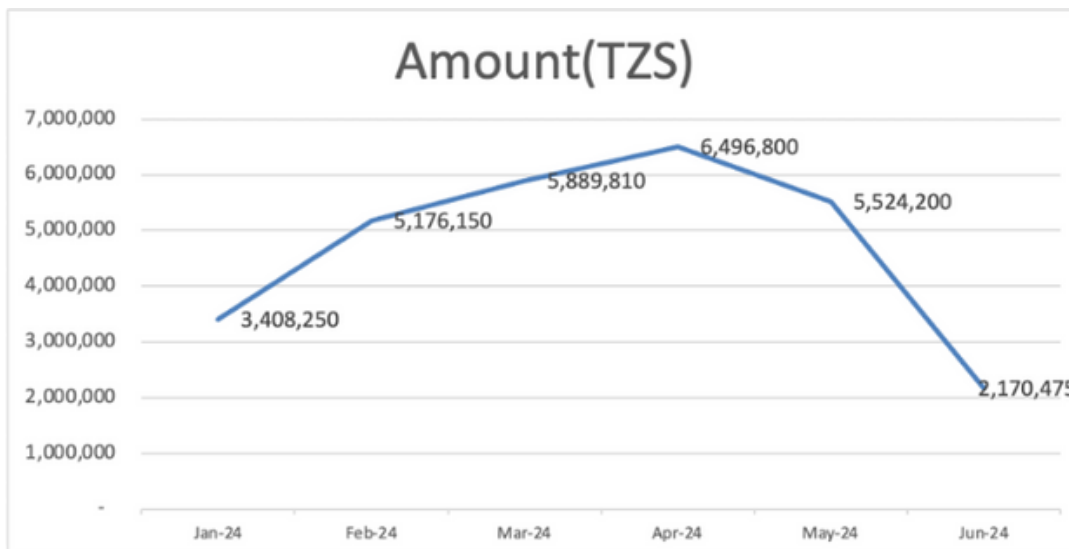






EXPENDITURE: NON-FOOD ITEM

The school spends an average of TZS 6,497,000 on food and other related materials. This represents a significant cost for the school to sustain. We understand that the quality of food has a substantial impact on student performance.



ORPHANAGE

Bethsaida Secondary School is often referred to as an "orphanage school" because its primary goal is to provide services rather than to generate profit. The school relies on support from various sources, including local community members, the private sector, the public sector, and international donors. These supporters typically contribute to covering teachers' salaries and essential operational costs such as electricity, utilities, and food for the children.

However, the COVID-19 pandemic, followed by the ongoing conflict between Russia and Ukraine, led to a significant reduction in donor support, with 96% of donors withdrawing their contributions. This situation also negatively impacted support from local institutions, further affecting the school's operations.

Currently, the school serves over 112 students who are in need of continued support to sustain the center's functions and ensure the students' well-being and education.

Support Request: Financial Needs Assessment

Bethsaida Secondary School has numerous needs, but we have highlighted a few critical areas that require immediate attention and support:

Teachers' and Staff Salaries: The school faces a monthly deficit of TZS 10,425,000 to cover the salaries of teachers and other staff members. Timely support in this area is crucial to ensure that our dedicated team can continue providing quality education and care.

Student Support Donations: Currently, over 76 students from the local community lack financial support. We are seeking contributions from individuals and institutions to help cover their educational expenses.

Internet Access and Technology: To enhance the learning environment, we need 10 laptops for teachers and 20 laptops for students. Additionally, providing desktop computers for students will significantly improve their access to digital resources and educational tools.

School Rehabilitation: Since its establishment in 2006, the school has not undergone major rehabilitation. An analysis indicates that approximately TZS 28,450,000 is needed for essential repairs and upgrades, including maintenance of the kitchen, water pipes and tanks, classrooms, and the guest house.

Student Food and Operational Costs: The average monthly expenditure for student food and other operational costs ranges between TZS 5,000,000 and TZS 7,000,000. Consistent support in this area is vital to ensure that students receive proper nutrition and that daily operations continue smoothly.

Women's Needs: While this document highlights several key areas of need, it is important to acknowledge that there are numerous specific needs related to our female students that are not detailed here. We recognize the importance of addressing these needs and are open to discussing and addressing them further. We welcome any support or contributions aimed at meeting the diverse needs of our girls.
